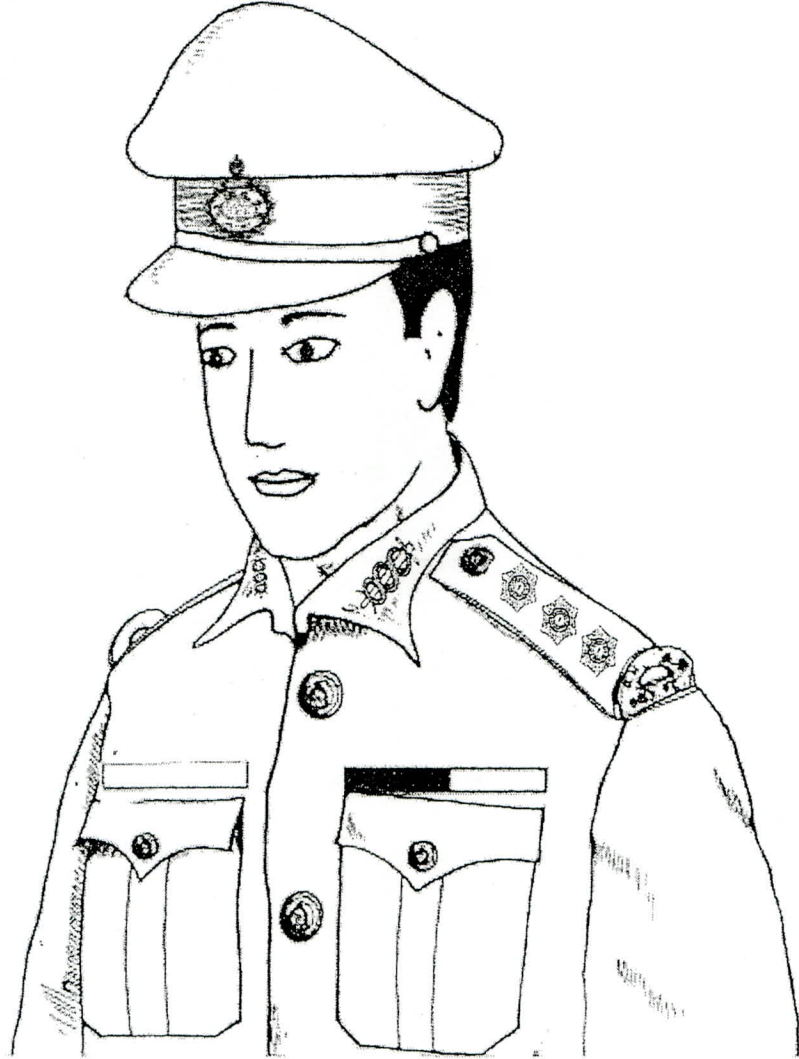

1. Large button displaying D.H. and national emblem (diameter 24 mm)



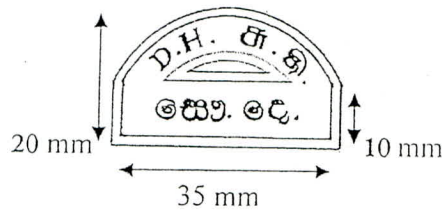

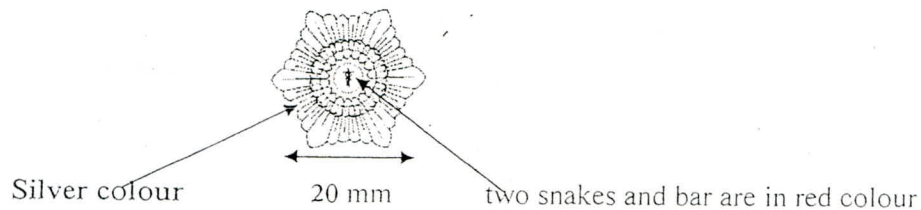
3. Small button displaying D.H. and national emblem for the P- cap (diameter 15 mm)



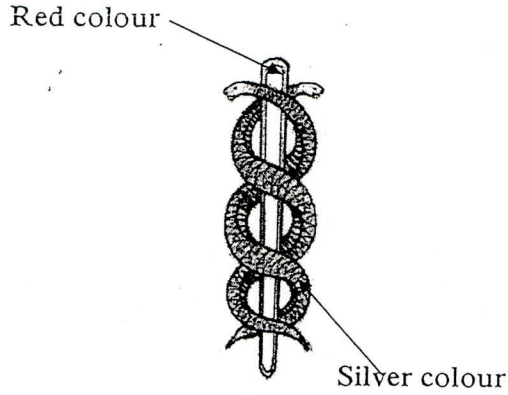
4. Metal shoulder badge displaying D.H.

7. Metal national emblem of Sri Lanka



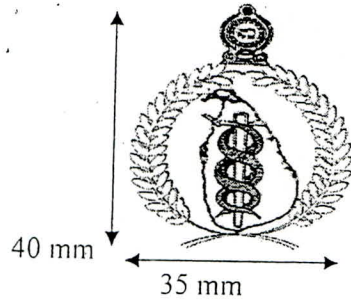

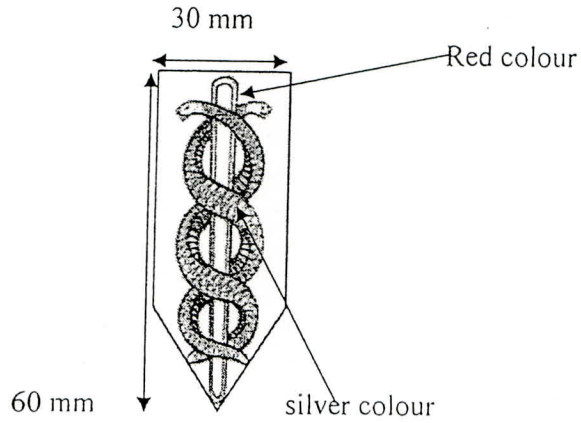
9. Special metal badge worn on the Epulette for the Provincial Chief Public Health Inspector

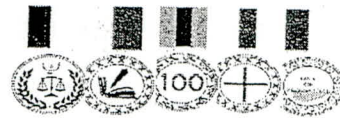

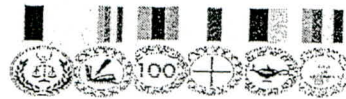

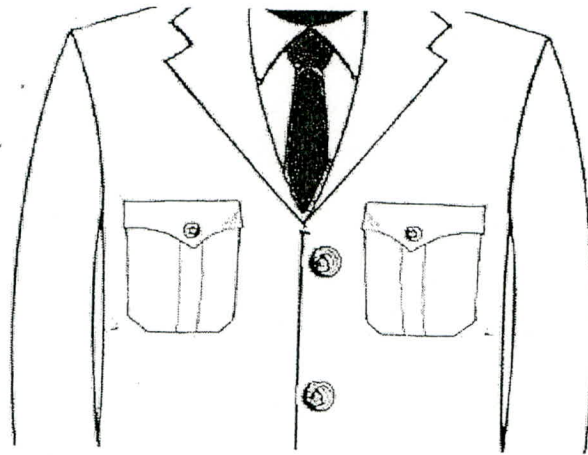

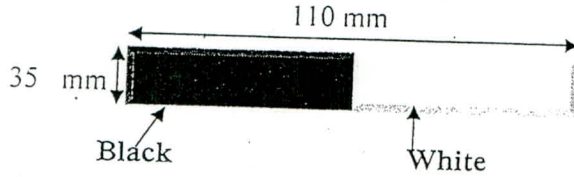

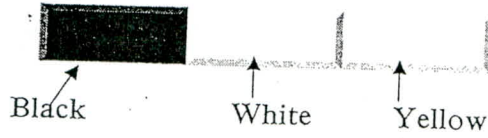

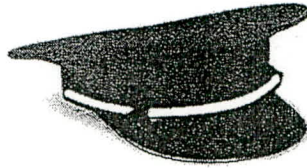

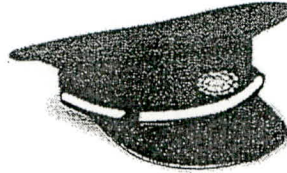

Black in colour, a black and white long bands runs around the crown of the cap from the front

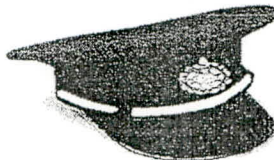
