It is hereby notified that the Efficiency Bar Examination which should be passed by Public Health Inspectors in seg II "A" / Grade II with in three years from the date of promotion to Grade II, will be held respectively in the medium of Sinhala, Tamil and English. The date, venue and the time of examination will be notified in the admission card.

02. Qualifications

Officers who have been appointed to the class II Segment "A" of the Public Health Inspectors Service by 2021/08/28 and Who have not Passed the said Examination as yet can apply for this Examination.

N.B Take necessary actions to send applications of the officers only who has been promoted to Class II segmant "A" by 28/08/2021 and already received the appointment letters.

03. Applications

Applications prepared by the candidates as per specimen appended to this circcular should be sent under registered cover to reach the Director (Examinations) "Suwasiripaya" No.385, Ven. Baddegama Wimalawansa Thero Mawatha, Colombo 10, on or before 28/08/2021 through the respective Head of Institution. The Head of Division should certify the accuracy of contents in each application. Three self addressed envelopes (Candidates can write their official or private address) in the size of 9" x 4" inches, affixed with stamps to the value of Rs. 45.00 should be sent along with the application. Applications which are received late, incomplete or inaccurate will be rejected.

Note: The Application should be prepared using an A4 Paper based on the specimen form of application so to recommended from No 01 to 04 on the first page and from 04 to 09 on the second page. Applications, that do not comply with the above format will be rejected without any notice.

04. Examination fees:-

Efficiency Bar Examination consists two papers viz. Establishments Code and procedural Rules and Financial Regulations Each paper is given 100 marks. Minimum 40 marks should be obtained for each subject to pass the examination.

The examination can be completed in one or several sittings. Applicants who sit for the examination for the first time should apply for all subjects.
