Therefore, you are kindly requested to submit **02 nominations** along with the following documents **on or before 05 November 2019**.

- 1. Duly filled Application Form.
- 2. A copy of the passport (The expiry date of the passport shall be not less than 6 months from the ending of the Seminar).
- 3. Duly filled ERD Form
- 4. Medical Report (All the applicants without considering the age have to provide the medical report).

General conditions for Chinese training programmes.

- Age limit is under 45 for Director or under Director Level and under 50 for Director General's level. (If overage officers are being nominated, a recommendation on nominee's working ability and health condition is required. This should be submitted by nominee's Department or Institution, addressing to the Commercial Counselor of Chinese Embassy in Sri Lanka. However this should not guarantee that the overage nominations will be accepted all times).
- Should send only the requested number of nominations.
- One official can apply only for one programme at once.

- Applications will not be accepted after ERD closing date.
- Some training programmes could be cancelled or postponed.
- Scheduled dates of the training programmes could be changed due to unavoidable circumstances occurred by the Chinese government.
- Selected Participants may be informed by the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Sri Lanka most probably within one week before the training programmes begin.
- All the selected participants must wear a formal dress when they meet the officials at the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Sri Lanka and they should be there on time.
- Air Tickets may be issued most probably one day before the departure.
- Selected participants should participate in all the lectures & all events conducted under the training programme.

About the Organizer	Jiangsu Institute of Parasitic Diseases (JIPD), founded in July 1950, is located in Meiyuan, Wuxi – a natural scenic zone on Tai Lake, which is regarded as one of the most beautiful cities in China. It is a specialized research institute for the prevention and control of parasitic diseases. It is the first batch of master's degree awards approved by the State Council. It has a team of parasitic experts consisting of a number of masters and doctors who have studied abroad and rich in malaria and schistosomiasis prevention and research experience. In addition, the teachers include infectious disease experts and technicians from the National CDC and the Jiangsu Provincial CDC. Since 2002, the Ministry of Commerce has commissioned a total of 52 training programs on malaria and schistosomiasis, and trained more than 1,500 technical and management personnel for the 70 developing countries in Africa, the Americas and Southeast Asia. JIPD composed of Department of Schistosomiasis Control, Department of Malaria Control, Department of Filariasis & Intestinal Helminthiasis, Research Department, Editorial Office, Training Centre, Health Examination Centre and Clinic Service, Key Laboratory on Technology for Parasitic Disease Prevention and Control, Ministry of Health. It equipped with conference building, boarding rooms and entertainment rooms is in a beautiful campus of the institute. Falling into the subtropical monsoon climate belt, Wuxi is characterized by four distinct seasons. Average temperature in December is around 5°C-15°C.			
Seminar/ Training Course Content	This seminar consists of two parts: special lectures and on-site inspection. The lectures mainly include: 1. Summary of infectious diseases; 2. AIDS epidemic situation and response, case analysis in China and Jiangsu Province; 3. Tuberculosis epidemic situation and response, case analysis in China and Jiangsu Province; 4. Prevention and control of insect-borne diseases and elimination of experience such as malaria, schistosomiasis, zika, dengue fever, etc. 5. China's planned immunization process, current work introduction; 6. Infectious disease epidemic report and management, etc. The on-site inspection mainly includes organizing participants to go to disease control institutions, hospitals, universities and other professional institutions to gain in-depth understanding of China's infectious disease prevention and control and research experience; and also to go to relevant drug research and development enterprises to learn about the R&D and production of various anti-infectious drugs in China. In addition to these official activities, we will also organize participants to visiting and sightseeing in surrounding areas of Wuxi as the city of Suzhou and Shanghai, to find Chinese cultures and customs for help enriching their life and understand Chinese rich culture and its long history. Through the training, the participants will have a more comprehensive understanding of China and China's infectious diseases situation, especially preventive control strategies and technical methods. It provides reference for their own national disease prevention and control. These are all good foundations for further exchanges and cooperation between			

China and developing countries in infectious diseases prevention and control.
