Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. The course will be held over 5 days from 30 August 2021 to 3 September 2021.

- Mid- to senior-level government officials from health ministries, hospitals, and other healthcare agencies.
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. Participants will require an internet-enabled device with a functioning webcam, microphone and audio.

- · Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.
