Objectives of MTCF

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCF)

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCF) was officially launched on 7 September 1980 at the Commonwealth Heads of State Meeting in New Delhi, India, to signify Malaysia's commitment to the South-South Cooperation, in particular, the Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).

The MTCF emphasizes on the development of human resources through the provision of trainings in various areas which are essential for a country's development such as the economy, finance, public management and administration, science and technology and ICT, health diplomacy, safety and security including cybersecurity, cultural diplomacy, social development, environment-related to SDG2030, education, industrial and technical training. Annually, Malaysia offered more than 60 technical and capacity-building programs under the MTCF, which have benefited more than 35,500 participants from 144 countries.
