About the Organizer

The International Poverty Reduction Center in China (IPRCC) was established in May 2005 as one of outcomes of Shanghai Global Conference on Scaling Up Poverty Reduction in 2004, IPRCC was jointly initiated and established by the Chinese government, the UNDP, the World Bank and other international organizations. It is designed for research, training, exchange, collaboration and knowledge sharing in poverty reduction. IPRCC is committed to the internationalization of China's poverty reduction experience, as well as the localization of global experience, so as to forge an integrated platform for poverty reduction and development. Since 2005 to the end of 2022, IPRCC has successfully held 182 seminars, with 5115 participants from 138 countries. IPRCC has developed training textbooks such as "Ten Keys to Understanding China's Poverty Reduction", video textbooks and micro video cases teaching materials. In the central and western regions in China, 15 provinces have been identified as "China Poverty Alleviation Exchange Base". Participants can be arranged to visit the bases for field visits and feel the effects of poverty alleviation policies and practices. IPRCC is also equipped with an international training team that understands business, knows foreign languages and has high quality. At the same time, it has compiled and printed the international training manual for poverty reduction, which has strengthened the standardized management and promoted the high-quality development of project implementation. Seminar/ Training Course Content The project is themed is themed "Poverty Eradication and Rural Revitalization", which mainly focuses the strategic deployment, policies and measures, and organization implementation of comprehensive and coordinated rural development and sustainable poverty reduction, shows the policy measures, implementation models, as well as experience and inspirations in poverty reduction and rural revitalization in China, analyzes the problems and challenges faced by developing countries in promoting agricultural modernization and comprehensive rural development, constructs a new model of coordinated national economic and social development, and explores ways and measures to improve the strategic system and implementation model of poverty eradication and rural development. The training activities of the seminar are divided into three parts: thematic lectures, discussion exchange, and field visit.

I. Thematic Lectures: Including one public course and ten core courses.

(1) Public Course

China's economic and social development strategies and achievements. This course will mainly introduce China's basic national conditions and the main achievements, strategic initiatives, models and mechanisms, as well as experience and inspirations of China's economic and social development.

(II) Core Courses

- 1. Policies and practice of China's poverty alleviation. This course will mainly introduce the strategic deployment, implementation mechanism, policies and measures, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in China's poverty alleviation.
- 2. Policies and practice of China's rural revitalization. This course will mainly introduce the strategic deployment, implementation mechanism, policies and measures, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in China's rural revitalization.
- 3. China's policies and practice of the rural modern industrial development. This course will mainly introduce the strategic framework, policies and measures,

achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in transforming traditional agriculture, promoting the transformation and upgrading of agricultural industrial system.

- 4. China's policy and practice of rural employment development. This course will mainly introduce the strategic framework, policies and measures, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in China's rural employment development.
- 5. China's policy and practice of the development of rural education. This course will mainly introduce the development history, basic features, strategic framework, policies and measures, implementation methods, as well as experience and inspiration of China's rural education.
- 6. Policy and practice of China's healthcare services in rural areas. This course will mainly introduce the theoretical relationship between medical development and poverty reduction, the history, basic features, strategic framework, policy practices, as well as the experience and inspirations of China's healthcare services in rural areas
- 7. China's ecological development policy and practice. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, main achievements, mechanism model, as well as the experience and inspirations in promoting rural ecological revitalization in China.
- 8. China's policy and practice of rural science and technology development. This course will mainly introduce the strategic framework, policies and measures, implementation mode, achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in promoting the development of rural science and technology in China.
- 9. Policies and practices of rural social security development in China. This course will mainly introduce the policy and measures, implementation mechanism, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in rural social security in China.
- 10. China's policies and practice of the development of rural grass-roots governance system. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, working mechanisms, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in improving the rural grass-roots governance system and improving the modernization level of rural governance in China.
