1 COURSE TITLE

This training programme is entitled, "Pandemic Risk Reduction & Management".

2 BACKGROUND

Malaysia supports 144 developing countries under the framework of the South-South Cooperation since 1980 via the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP). In 1983, Japan started its Third Country Training Programme (TCTP) in Malaysia. Subsequently, Malaysia and Japan began to collaborate in 1992 to assist developing countries under the MTCP Recipient List within this TCTP arrangement.

The Malaysian Medical Relief Society, also known as MERCY Malaysia, is a medical relief organization dedicated to providing humanitarian aid in crisis and non-crisis situation irrespective of race, religion, culture and boundary.

MERCY Malaysia's first mission was to Kosova in June 1999. Throughout the last two decades, MERCY Malaysia has evolved into a full-fledged humanitarian organisation offering the full spectrum of humanitarian services, from emergency response to rehabilitation and recovery, mitigation and prevention, disaster preparedness, and sustainable development.

In 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic had caused disruption to the world's and societies' social and economic landscape—impacting physical, mental and planetary health of many. Since the emergent of COVID-19 cases in Malaysia, MERCY Malaysia had played a massive role in assisting the government of Malaysia and the Ministry of Health (MOH) in providing medical support and services, as well as essential needs to at-risk and other marginalised community groups in the country.

MERCY Malaysia launched its COVID-19 Pandemic Fund to implement its COVID-19 Strategic Preparedness and Response Plan - a plan for humanitarian assistance to be delivered within a continuous cycle of total disaster risk management that focuses on prevention; preparedness; response; and recovery. All aid assistance and deliverables are coordinated with MOH and the National Crisis Preparedness and Response Centre (CPRC), and the National Agency for Disaster Management (NADMA).

Similar to Malaysia and other countries of the world, Japan also had its unique and challenging experiences in containing the spread of COVID-19, and in making sure its citizens are safe and are able to bounce back after the huge disruption. The Japanese Government took several steps to prevent the mass spread of the virus including through emergency measures that restricted public activities, strengthening the capacity of Japan's health facilities and quality of health care system and awareness program. Japanese experts promoted a "new way of living" concept where people will have to deal with the virus through behaviour adaptation.

In this course, MERCY Malaysia will share Malaysia's success stories, shortcomings and lesson learnt in responding and managing disaster in order to better understand best strategies, approaches, and methodologies. At the same time, we will share Japanese perspectives on how they handle the crisis.

3 THEME AND OBJECTIVES

Theme:

Pandemic response management and risk reduction – learning from the experiences of Malaysia and Japan.

Objectives:

To share experience and knowledge from both countries in managing responses, recovery and risk reduction on the global pandemic.

To learn from both successes and shortcomings of the pandemic preparedness and response plan and ground action to improve future planning and responses.

4 LEARNING OUTCOME

Upon completion of this course, participants would be able to:

- Understand appropriate pandemic preparedness and response planning that can be adopted to the context and needs of their countries and localities
- Enhance scientific, technical and strategic capacities on pandemic and other health preparedness and response planning
- Adopt and improvise relevant strategies based on case studies and lessons learnt from Malaysia and Japan
- Strategize initiatives in building community resilience in facing future health crisis

5 TARGET COUNTRIES, ORGANISATIONS AND PARTICIPANTS

5.1 Target Countries and Relevant Organisations / Agencies

5.2 Total Number and Target Participants

- The total number of participants for the course is fifteen (15).
- Middle/ senior level of government officials from government ministries, non-governmental agencies and civil societies in charge of health, pandemic-disaster response and recovery, and policy makers.

 Priority of selection will be given to applicants whose major task is to respond to pandemic-disaster and policy makers.

6 REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

Applicants of the course are obliged to fulfil the following requirements:

- Participant can be from government, non-government organization or civil societies who are involved either in pandemic-disaster management locally or internationally
- (2) Should be nominated and obtained approval by their respective country government (detailed procedure is stated in 13. APPLICATION PROCEDURE);
- (3) Should be able to provide a colour copy of passport or identity card;
- (4) Between 26-50 years of age;
- (5) Should come from middle to senior level of management.
- (6) Should have practical experience minimum three (3) to four (4) years in the area of disaster risk sensitivity and/or management and making policies;
- (7) Should possess basic computer literacy skills and good internet connectivity.
- (8) Should possess a good command of written and spoken English;
- (9) Good health, physically and mentally, in order to complete the course;
- (10) Not to be serving in the military; and
- (11) Women are encouraged to apply.

7 COURSE DESCRIPTION

7.1 Duration

The duration of the course is five (5) days from 27 February 2023 - 03 March 2023; 14:00-19:00 Malaysia (GMT+8).

7.2 Delivery and Language

The course will be delivered **through Zoom platform** by MERCY Malaysia, in **English**.

7.3 Curriculum and Schedule

• This course shall include online lectures and assignments related to Pandemic Risk Management. Schedule is attached in **15.1**.

7.4 Certificates

Certificates will be awarded upon successful completion of the course and submission of assignments.

8 ACTION PLAN

To fulfil the objectives of the course as stated in **3**, all participants must prepare a Plan of Action and present it on the last day of the course. Refer to **15.2**.

9 ALLOWANCES, BENEFITS, AND PARTICIPANTS' RESPONSIBILITIES

- (1) **No allowances will be paid** to the participants, including per-diem, transportation, accommodation, communication, any other incidental costs to the training participation.
- (2) Participants will, at their own risk and expense, <u>set up all communications</u> <u>environment such as the internet and provide all equipment and devices</u> that are necessary for participants to access the online training.

10 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF TCTP PARTICIPANTS

All applicants are subjected to abide by the following conditions of TCTP participants throughout the course.

Participants shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner compatible with their responsibilities as TCTP participants and abide by laws, rules and regulations and specific regulation of the organiser.

- (1) In the virtual classroom, participants are required to dress appropriately which includes long-sleeved shirts with ties, tailored pants and blazer or uniform for men. Lady participants are required to dress appropriately and modestly.
- (2) Participants are **REQUIRED TO ATTEND** the whole course by following the allocated time.
- (3) Participants are **NOT** allowed to leave the session at any time.
- (4) Participants are **NOT** allowed to conduct any political and/or commercial activities in any capacity whatsoever during the course.
- (5) Participants are strictly advised to have a **QUIET SURROUNDING** during the class session.

- (6) The TCTP participation may be terminated at any time due to unsatisfactory conduct, breach of the conditions of TCTP participants, failure to make satisfactory progress or as deemed necessary by the organiser.
- (7) Requests for change of course or extension of the training period will NOT be entertained. Participants should fully participate in all activities related to the course.

In addition to the conditions stipulated in above, TCTP participants are also required to observe the followings:

- (1) To observe the course schedule by punctual attendance;
- (2) To attend/participate actively in all virtual sessions;

- (4) To discontinue the course, should participants fall seriously ill and be considered unable to continue the course;
- (5) To refrain from committing any illegal or immoral acts. Should participants be found in contravention of this requirement, they will be barred from attending the course and will be asked to leave the course with immediate effect:
- (6) Participants who do not comply with the general conditions, regulations and obligations of the TCTP participants would be reported to their respective Embassies or High Commissions as well as to the Head of their respective organizations;
- (7) Participants will not utilise knowledge and skills acquired in the training for military purposes.
- (8) To not alter, decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer any or all of the information platform software in connection with the provision of the online training;


