Online Research Methodology Training

Introduction

Research is an essential component for improvement of the work environment and service delivery particularly in the health sector. Health care workers should have updated with evidence-based management to deliver better health care. This program will upgrade the knowledge and skills in research methods; giving opportunity to attend this program with minimum disturbance to the routing activities. Teaching Methods




Figure 1: Conceptual framework of the training program

The research training program will be delivered as a blended programme with the distance online training and the contact workshops at Colombo. Hands on skills will be developed during the contact workshops which will essential for research training. Figure 1 shows the framework of the training program. There will be three workshops (Each workshop from 9 am to 4 pm) to complete during the training program. These workshops include essential components for hands on skill development sessions. There are eight lessons to be completed with referring to online materials. Participants are expected to spend over 4-6 hours per week for studying each lesson.

Basic requirements to follow the training program

The program will be opened for all the categories of the employees of the Ministry of Health, undergraduates and other under graduate or post graduate students of higher education institutes of Sri Lanka and members of duly recognized professional organizations. (Course fee will not be charged for the above-mentioned categories). This online program will be conducted in English medium; the competency in English language and computer literacy will be an added advantage. The program includes three compulsory workshops (Approximately one workshop for a month), online lessons and the post test. A certificate will be awarded to those who are complete all the components of the program.

Since the participants need to access online lessons, availability of internet and a personnel computers/laptop/tablet is essential.
