The name list of Medical Officers who are newly approved and rejected for re-attachment for the year 2021 are attached herewith, after considering the requests of all the stakeholders.

Please be kind enough to note that,

- All the Medical Officers with approved re-attachment can stay in their current stations ONLY for a maximum period of three (03) months, from 01st January 2021.
- Personal skeleton files and salary particulars of approved re-attached Medical Officers must be sent to their transferred stations with immediate effect.
- Their salary must be paid upon reception of personal skeleton file and salary particulars, by the newly transferred station.
- The physical presence of re-attached Medical Officers to their new stations are not required, due to ongoing COVID – 19 outbreak.
- All the Medical Officers who are on transfer orders on or before 2019, without any approved reattachments and who are on transfer orders, must be released to the newly transferred station on or before 15th January 2021, as you are liable for audit queries for paying the salaries for such Medical Officers without the approval of the Secretary Health.

Implementation of Annual Transfers of Grade medical officers in 2021

All the Medical officers on annual transfer orders up to 2019 (without approved reattachment as per the published list) will be released from 15th of January 2021 in phasic mannar as follows;

- 2017 and beyond transfer orders on or before 15th January 2021
- 2018 transfer orders on or before 19th January 2021
- 2019 transfer orders on or before 22nd January 2021

Relevant name list of the all the eligible officers to be transferred are published on Ministry of Health website. Release letters will be issued by the Ministry of Health, as a measure to expedite and streamline the annual transfer implementation process in order to optimise the healthcare delivery process ensuring the efficiency, effectiveness and equity. Individual release letters must be generated and printed from the online transfer letter portal at the institutional level. All the medical officers are instructed to get their release letters from the current working station and report to the new station immediately as per the regulations mentioned in the Establishment Code Chapter 3.

Medical Officers who are completed 59 years of age can stay in the same station upon their wish.

Heads of institutions who are not adhering to the given instructions may be liable for disciplinary inquiries and audit queries as payment of salaries for the released medical officers will be a violation of financial regulations. Therefore, all the heads of institutions are requested to release eligible medical officers enabling them to report to their new duty stations as soon as possible, in order to keep the transfer process effective and streamlined.
